### RESEARCH: Continuing to Grow & Innovate

In 2023, we laid the groundwork for the Community Health Research Institute (CHRI) at the Tubman Center for Health & Freedom.

Our research ethos champions uplifting the insights and solutions that already exist within our communities. Through analysis and collaboration, CHRI focuses research on topics community prioritizes, crafting pivotal recommendations for public health and policy. As we surge forward, CHRI stands unwavering in its commitment to championing health equity, igniting innovation, and working toward a vibrant and liberated future.

We're immensely proud of our research team's 2023 achievements! They have infused our care model with community insights and passion. Their work strengthens our ties within our community and professional networks, while also yielding key policy and design recommendations vital to our mission of addressing harmful systems while working towards our collective healing.

### Visions for Our Wellness

Our Mental Wellness Vision Board (pictured to the right), made its debut in community this summer! Participants were asked to identify healing resources and modalities they are interested in, as well as those they currently rely on. We learned more about community wellness needs we can address through our services. We also worked to identify pathways for training community members to provide those services.



364 touchpoints with community

31% of participants want access to complementary and alternative medicine, but only 12% currently have access.









### **Additional Research Highlights:**

- Onboarded six research fellows, including two from the American Public Health Association/Kaiser Permanente Fellowship and fellows from the University of Washington.
- We strengthened our connection with mentors and other radical researchers in the community health field.
- Three Tubman Health research team members represented us at the American Public Health Association Annual Conference, and two presented!
- We created a centralized repository to store data, synergizing information flow and policies across our organization.
- We strenghtened protocols for data sharing and confidentiality to steward and protect community data.

- We completed multiple in-depth literature reviews on topics such as:
  - Billing for Integrative Medicine
  - Healthcare Payment Landscape (Federal, State, and Local)
  - Integrative Medicine Models in Comparable Communities
  - Internal Environments Design/ Retention for Healthcare Providers
- A group of our team members travelled to Oakland, California to conduct clinical tours of aligned organizations. Team members used our site visit guide to document and debrief experiences and learnings from the experience. It was an exciting field experience, and team members returned to Seattle with many ideas and reflections for how we move forward with our model of care.

# FREEDOM CLINIC AT RVLA: Infusing a Culture of Health

In 2023, the Freedom Clinic at Rainier Valley Leadership Academy uplifted the innovative ideas of our young people to shape groundbreaking services and create a vibrant space dedicated to fostering both personal and community autonomy in wellness.

We have meticulously created a beautiful, welcoming space that serves as a sanctuary for health and wellness. The Freedom Clinic is a known safe space with trusted adults to provide care and support scholars.

We continue to grow our team, with our Director of Health Services, Dr. Peter Asante joining our team in early 2024.

We were deeply moved to learn that two scholars have found inspiration to pursue healthcare careers through their experiences at the Freedom Clinic. This is a testament to the importance of having providers from our communities who lead with empathy, compassion, and love. We continue to be dedicated to supporting youth enter the healthcare field.



#### **Highlights Beyond the Clinic Walls:**

- Our Community Caretaking Training was a hit! Students received a stipend, CPR certification and their own first aid kits!
- Vibrant back-to-school kits were crafted for RVLA scholars, featuring items like elderberry, stress balls, scratch pads, pencils, and more.
- Thanks to our hygiene closet, scholars enjoyed convenient access to a range of self-care essentials, from soothing cough drops to refreshing deodorant and hygiene products.
- A dynamic stress-busting drawer was introduced, offering scholars innovative tools and techniques to conquer stress.
- We hosted Herbal DIY holiday gift events, educating about aromatherapy and spreading the joy of holistic wellness.
- Our herbal tea-making station quickly became a beloved hotspot among scholars, delighting taste buds and teaching the medicinal properties of herbs.
- We introduced the Healthy Foods Vending Machine! Free of candy and soda, scholars can now access healthy snacks when they need them.













### **BUILDING THE CENTER**

Community has reimagined healthcare. Now we're building the healthcare model we deserve and need. A healthcare model that honors generations of wisdom, acts on our desires, and builds on our communal networks.

The need for the Tubman Center for Health & Freedom is loud and clear. As we design and construct our 40,000 square-foot health center slated to open its doors in 2027, we've been diligently building capacity to refine our community-designed model of care.

At the Freedom Clinic at Rainier Valley Leadership Academy, we have the capacity to serve 250 community members. And, in 2024, we'll proudly open the Healing House, extending transformational services to an additional 250 community members.

We are acutely aware of the deep-seated need within our community for access to our services. Our journey towards the Center continues unabated, with the knowledge that we'll have capacity to serve 8,000-12,000 primary care patients, while also touching the lives of an additional 16,000 community members through health promotion initiatives.

### POLICY ADVOCACY: Leading & Engaging

Organizing for systems change remains central to Tubman Health's model. We are steadfast in our commitment to addressing health through both clinical and systemic approaches, which includes actively engaging elected officials to address the systems that make our communities unwell. Our efforts extend to building intersectoral partnerships, advocating for health justice, and amplifying community voice to advocate for investment in community-led health solutions.



### **State Legislative Session 2023**

During the 2023 legislative session, Tubman Health successfully secured an \$11.7 million capital investment from the Washington State Legislature to support our project in building the Center. Our successes are fueled by passionate advocacy and deep partnership. The champions who keep Tubman Health in the legislative dialogue. The legislators who see the promise of our vision. The community supporters who have our back and support us in the moments where it counts the most. Our base is strong! We approach all of our work from the lens of community organizing.

#### Additional Highlights:

- 20 state legislators and hundreds of community members signed a letter in support of Tubman Health's capital project to build our transformative health center.
- Tubman Health continues to be active in Olympia, building relationships, taking legislative meetings, and speaking in public hearings to advance our work.
- In February 2023, we hosted legislators for a legislative engagement event to thank them for their partnership as we advance #MedicineforthePeople.
- In February 2024, a group of Tubman Health board and staff went down to Olympia to spread the word on how Tubman Health is innovating solutions for the most pressing health equity challenges facing our state.

### Celebrating Our Successes Together

In June, Tubman Health hosted our district's state legislators and King County/ Seattle City Councilmembers, along with our community partners. 




### Tubman Health Revenue Breakdown






### Tubman Health Grant Breakdown
